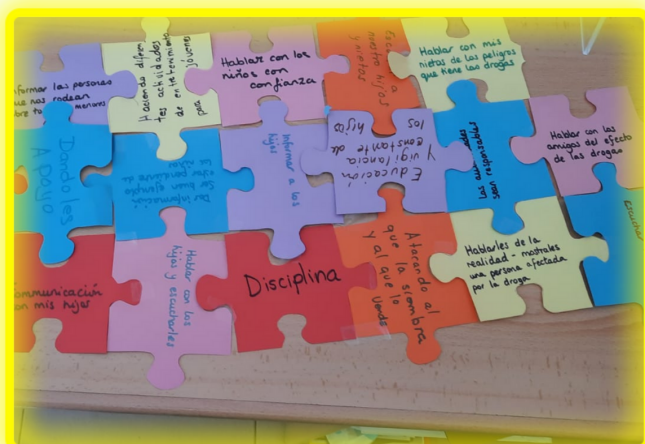

OLIVE TREES ARE PECULIAR

“The olive tree grows slowly because annual rainfall in the Mediterranean zone is so low, and it’s not possible for it to grow faster. When you have olive trees in a pot or a fertilized garden, it does grow at a faster pace each year. But on a farm, it will need 15 years to begin producing, and several decades to become big. Its life expectancy is 2,000 years, an extraordinary age for a perennial tree.”
